STAR is a safety incentive program that serves to improve safety awareness by rewarding safe working habits and the participation in continuing safety education programs.

In order to qualify for the program you must meet the following qualifications:

- ◆ Work at least 640 safe working hours without a workers' compensation claim between January 1, 2008 and September 30, 2008*
- ◆ Complete at least two of the health and safety classes listed on the attached list
- ◆ Be a member in good standing with your Local Union (not be suspended)

You must be in attendance at the annual STAR Awards Ceremony in order to win prizes. Each qualifying participant will have one entry for the GRAND PRIZE and one entry for the General Prizes. For each two classes that the qualifying participant completes he/she will have one entry for the Local Union prizes.

*Certification of Accident, Illness and Claim-Free Status: Each eligible member must sign attesting that he/ she has not filed any workers' compensation claims for work performed during the qualifying period. Members must have their employer submit the required Accident & Safety Free Certification Form to demonstrate a certain amount of Safe Hours.

The STAR Committee reserves the right to resolve all issues or disputes in regard to differing eligibility requirements.
